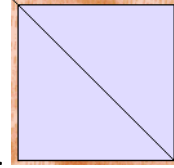


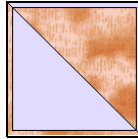
Windmill Flying Geese

4 - 3" x 5" rectangle orange , 2 - brown 7" squares , 2 - 5.5" squares ( 2 different colors)



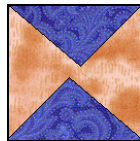
Make eight Flying Geese. Lay small square on top of the larger centering it .

With right side together. Draw diagonally from one corner to the other a line. Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from this drawn line on both sides. Cut apart on the drawn line. Open and press. Lay these two pieces on top of each other with right side together, different colors on opposite side and the 2 corners without seams matching.

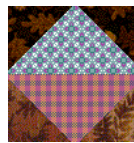


Do not match the sewn seams in the middle.


Draw another line diagonally thru the seams. Sew on both side of the marked line. Cut apart on drawn line.



You will have pieces that looks like this .Press. Cut apart leaving  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance at the blue goose tip.Trim the long side.



Sew these units together with the point facing out ward . Now you' ll have 4 units.

Put aside and sew the orange windmill piece, 3" x 5" rectangle.  Fold in half on the long side, sew a seam from the edge to the folded edge(one edge only). Turn inside out a point, press. Trim. Sew this triangle piece to the Flying Geese as shown , sew all pieces together . Add button or fancy decoration to hold down the windmill flap.
